



## WHAT IS RECITAL?

Apologies for not sending this info earlier, we weren't sure if we'd be able to have a recital this year. But we are now planning for one!

Here, at A frost Dance Experience, we are so used to talking about recital and costumes that we sometimes forget that there are new students and parents that are not familiar with it.

A few parents have reached out to us asking about what recital is? when is it? how does it work?

Recital is the opportunity to see all our classes together on stage to celebrate the year. The dancers work on choreography, each class putting together a routine for their recital piece.

They all get dressed in sparkly costumes, put some makeup on (trust us, not too much make up) and perform their amazing routines for all their families.

Recital takes place on a stage in an auditorium (usually at a high school theatre) and it's an exciting day for all the studio families. We get to take photos and receive some flowers at the end for all performances.

Right now, we are almost ready to order costumes, we have been choosing designs and suppliers and are taking measurements, so costumes fit great. It's an exciting day when costumes arrive, and dancers get to try them on.

We have included the cost of costumes in the invoices we are about to send out to you. If you decide, for any reason, that your child is not participating in recital, please let us know and deduct the cost of the costumes from your invoice when you are sending payment.

We have tentative Recital dates for June 3rd to 5th, 2022. Students also gather at the same auditorium/theatre for a dress rehearsal during the week of recital. We are working to find the best stage possible for our dancers, they deserve to have a live recital this year.
